
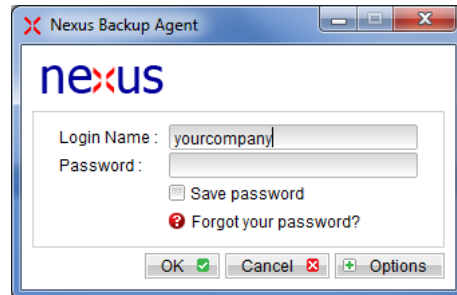


- 1 Double click the Nexus  in the system tray (beside the clock).
If you cannot see the icon, try going to the Start menu, Programs and Nexus Backup.

- 2 If prompted, enter your password.

It is essential you record your password and keep it in a safe place. Your data may not be recoverable if you lose your password.

If you have forgotten your password, please contact Nexus.



- 3 Click the "Restore" button.



- 4 Select the backup set you wish to restore files from.

- 5 Select files to be restored and click the "Start Restore" button.

You can restore deleted files or restore from a previous date by selecting the date of a previous backup.

You can restore previous versions of a file by selecting the "Show all files" option.

Browse to locate your files and folders to be restored.

It is highly recommended to select an "alternate location" to restore the data first. This allows you the opportunity to test the restored data before possibly over-writing the original data.

Did you know you can perform a restore from anywhere in the world?

Simply log in to the Nexus website with your user name and password to restore your data without the use of the backup software.
